

## **Shadow Ministry Appointments**

## June 2014

On Friday 18 October 2013 Opposition Leader the Hon <u>Bill Shorten</u> MP assigned Shadow Ministry portfolios and appointed the Shadow Parliamentary Secretaries.

These portfolio assignments and appointments follow on from the election of the Opposition front bench on Monday 14 October by the Federal Labor Caucus.

At the Caucus meeting, the Hon <u>Tanya Plibersek</u> MP was elected as Deputy Leader of the Federal Parliamentary Labor Party, Senator the Hon <u>Penny Wong</u> was elected Leader of the Opposition in the Senate and Senator the Hon <u>Stephen Conroy</u> was elected Labor's Deputy Leader in the Senate.

The process for electing both the Labor Leader and Shadow Ministry followed the rules adopted by the Federal Labor Caucus at the 22 July 2013 special Caucus meeting. Under the rules, the power to pick the frontbench was returned to the Federal Labor Caucus.

On 24 June Opposition Leader Shorten announced changes to the Shadow Executive due to the expiry of the Senate terms of six Labor Senators on 30 June.

On 24 September 2014 Opposition Leader the Hon Bill Shorten MP appointed the Hon Anthony Albanese MP Shadow Minister for Cities, adding to his current portfolios as Shadow Minister for Infrastructure and Transport and Shadow Minister for Tourism.
